ACCOUNTABILITY BALANCE BEAM: ACHIEVING RESULTS THROUGH ENGINEERING ACCOUNTABILITY

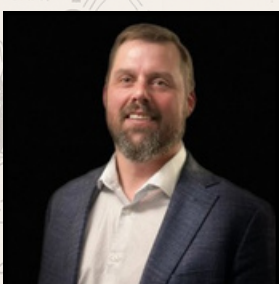
