I look forward to working with you to preserve what makes Helena special while building towards a sustainable future. Now, let's get to work!

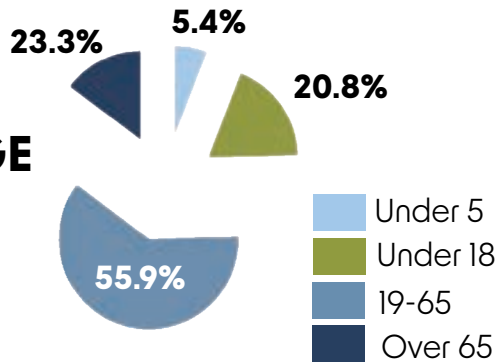

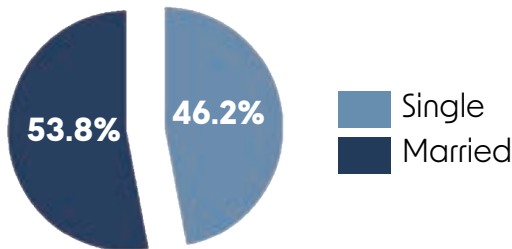

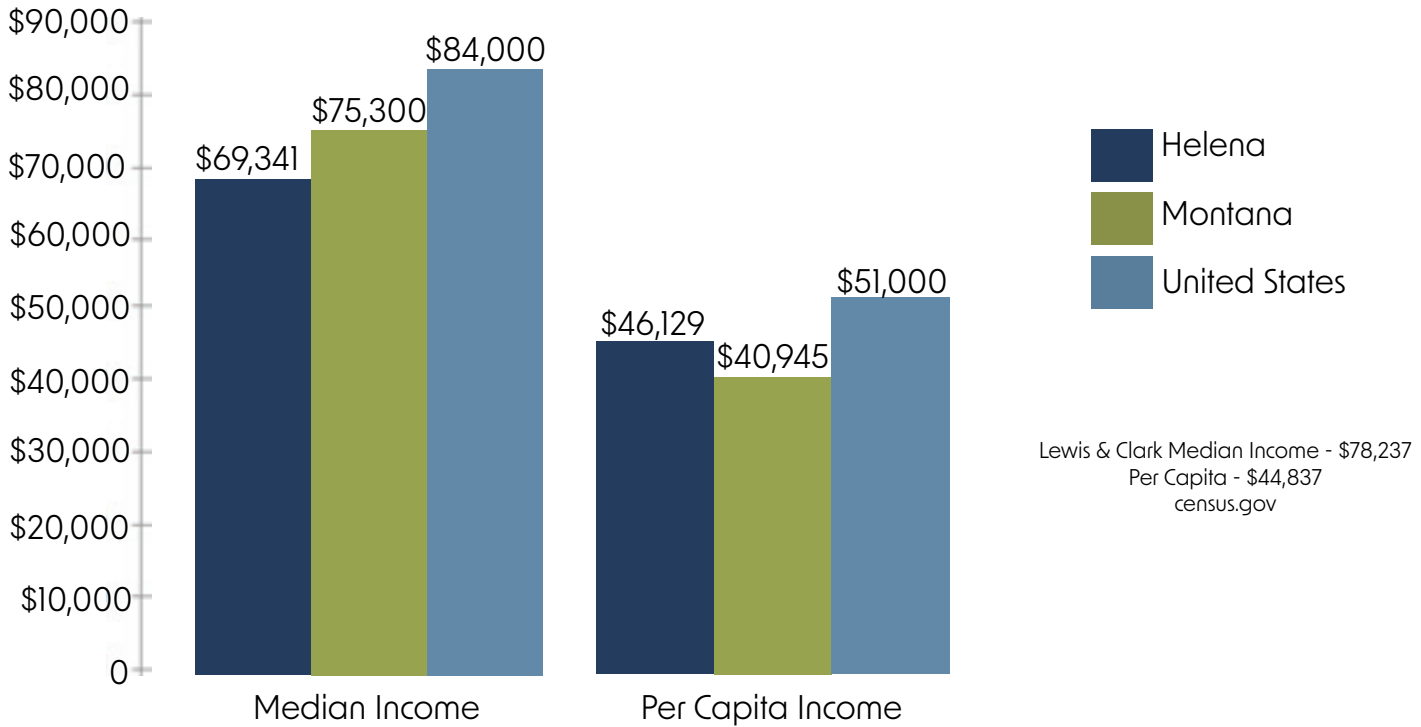

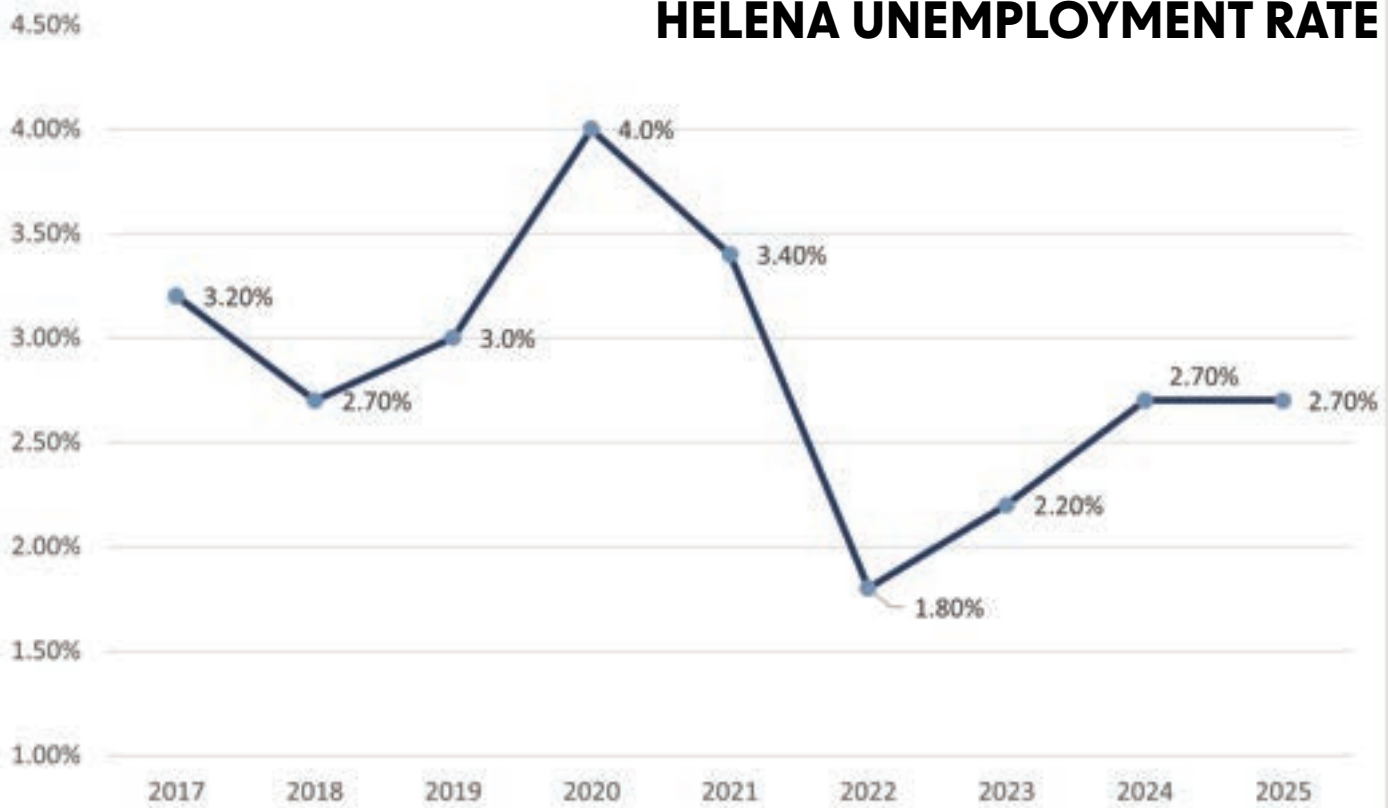

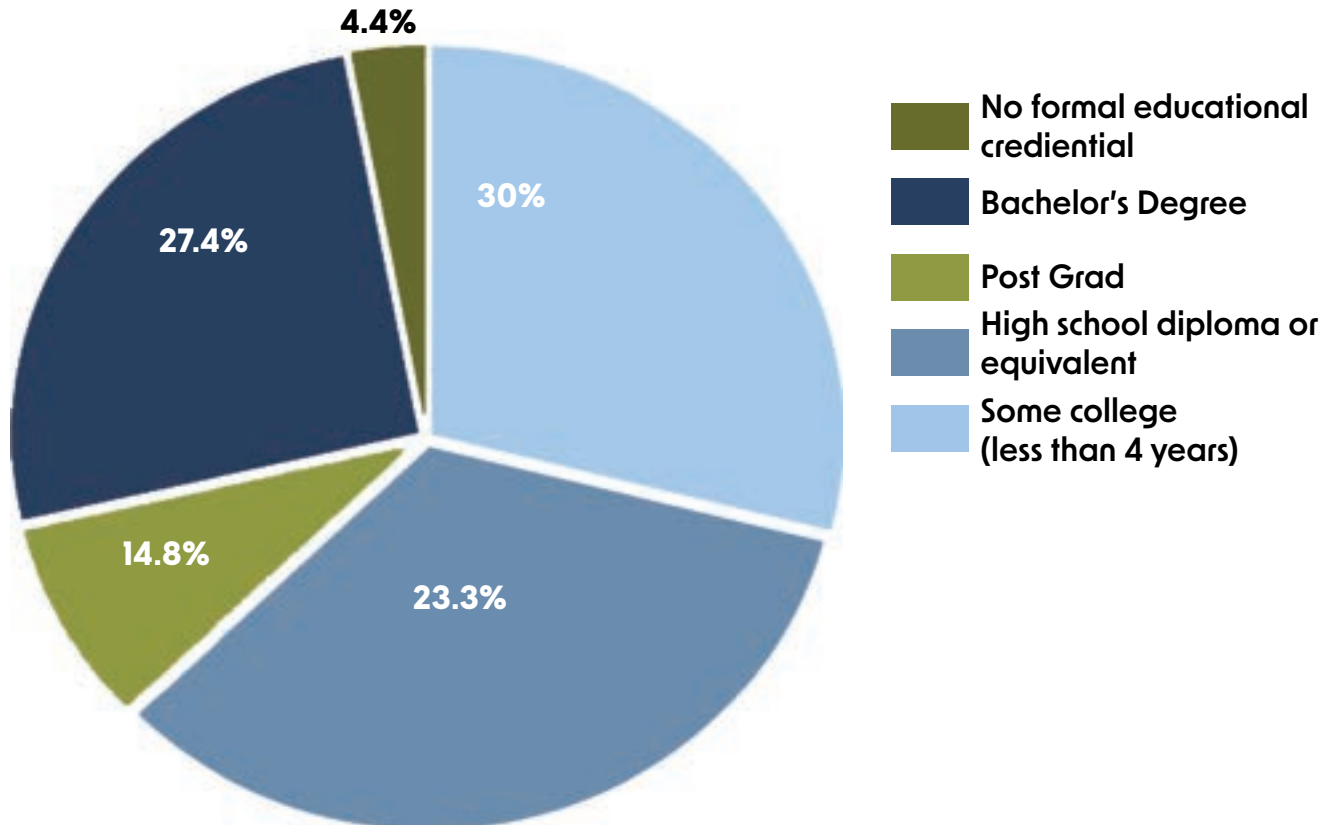

A Campus That Blends Tradition and Innovation

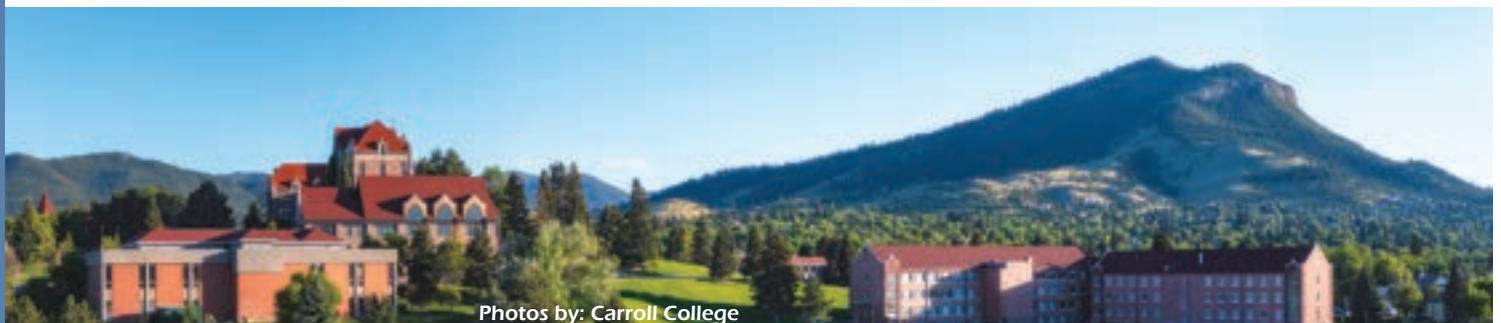

St. Peter's Health

St. Peter's Health is a not-for-profit health system guided by its mission to improve the health, wellness and quality of life of the people and communities it serves. St. Peter's has a 99-bed acute care hospital (regional medical center), primary and specialty care clinics, cancer care, behavioral health unit, urgent care clinics, home health and hospice care, dialysis clinic and ambulance services. St. Peter's provides care for an estimated 97,000 residents in a five-county area including Lewis and Clark, Broadwater, Powell, Meagher and Jefferson counties.



St. Peter's is a DNV-GL Health Care accredited organization and is the first hospital in Montana to receive the prestigious ISO-9001 quality management certification. St. Peter's is governed by a volunteer board of directors that includes leaders and health experts who serve as fiscal stewards of the community's health care dollars and resources. St. Peter's employs more than 1,800 people, including over 130 physicians and advanced practice providers in more than 20 specialties at locations in Helena and throughout the service area.

In 2025, St. Peter's opened a new \$5 million nephrology and dialysis clinic, providing a major boost to patient care and community health by offering ten state-of-the-art hemodialysis stations, cutting-edge equipment, and two dedicated home-therapy rooms that support education and expanded access to at-home dialysis. These enhancements improve treatment quality for individuals with end-stage kidney failure and strengthen access for rural patients who previously faced travel challenges. As the only hospital-based program in Montana offering specialized home-dialysis treatment plans—and with nearly half of its patients managing dialysis from home—the clinic significantly elevates care options while reinforcing the region's leadership in kidney-transplant success.

Additionally, St. Peter's Health was designated as a DNV Orthopedic Center of Excellence in 2025, asserting it has met the highest standards of quality and excellence in all aspects of orthopedic care including surgery, diagnostic services and therapies. St. Peter's also doubled the size of its orthopedic team in 2025, making it one of the largest and most comprehensive orthopedic practices in the region. This expansion increases access to specialized services—including joint replacement, spine surgery, sports medicine, pediatric orthopedics, trauma care and interventional pain management—while enhancing continuity of care through the addition of physicians, advanced practice providers, athletic trainers and support staff.

St. Peter's is equally committed to donating time and money to community-based services that address key health challenges or improve the health and wellness of its residents. For example, St. Peter's community health workers play a crucial role in Helena's Frequent Users of System Engagement (FUSE) initiative, which works to reduce the need for emergency health care visits and facilitate stable housing for community members. St. Peter's also launched its Mobile Crisis Response Team (MCRT) in 2020 through a partnership with Lewis and Clark County. MCRT works throughout the community alongside local law enforcement to provide mental health crisis intervention services that help community members avoid jail or emergency room visits.

Surgical services – Specialty surgical services provided at St. Peter's include robotic surgery, as well as dental; ear, nose and throat; general; gynecologic; orthopedic; podiatry; and urologic services.

Urgent Care – Urgent Care services at St. Peter's are available seven days a week at two convenient walk-in locations at the St. Peter's Health Regional Medical Center and St. Peter's Health Medical Group – North Clinic.

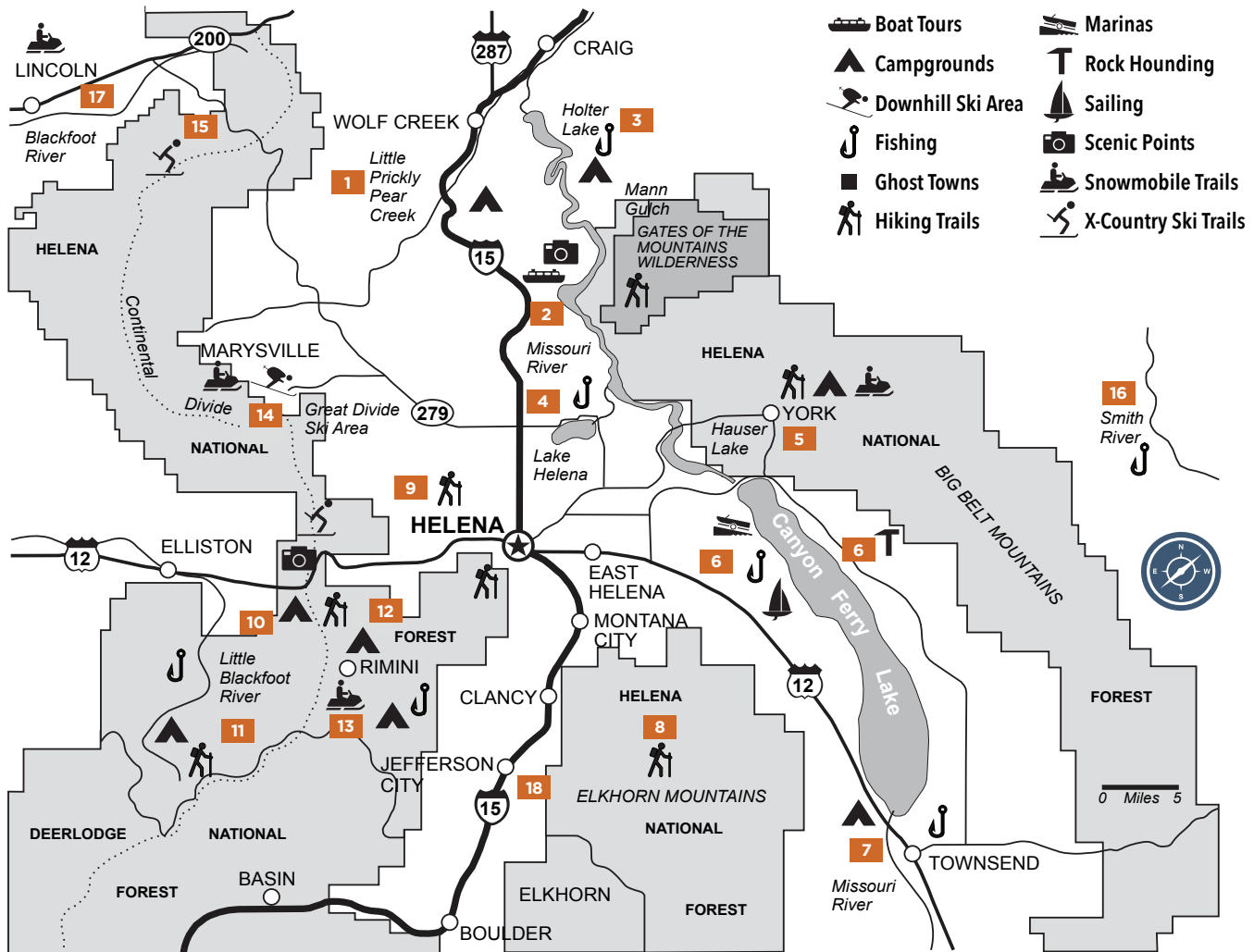

- 1** Wolf Creek Canyon offers camping and fishing along Recreation Road.
- 2** Gates of the Mountains offers boat tours along the historic Missouri River, featuring stops at Meriwether Campground near the site of the tragic 1949 Mann Gulch Fire.
- 3** Holter Lake has camping and fishing along the eastern shore.
- 4** Lake Helena is a popular, year-round fishing and bird watching area.
- 5** The Helena National Forest surrounding the town of York has snowmobile and hiking trails as well as Vigilante Campground.
- 6** Canyon Ferry Lake is the center for water sports in the Helena area, offering complete boating services, campgrounds, and both public and private marinas.
- 7** The Townsend Area offers boating and fishing on Canyon Ferry Lake and the Missouri River.
- 8** The Elkhorn Mountains have scenic mountain trails and the ghost town of Elkhorn.
- 9** Spring Meadow State Park within the Capital City itself offers swimming, hiking, and fishing. Mount Helena City Park has 6 miles of hiking trails, plus access to the Mount Helena Ridge National Recreation Trail.
- 10** MacDonald Pass, 20 miles west of Helena, offers camping, cross-country skiing and hiking along the Continental Divide National Scenic Trail.
- 11** The Little Blackfoot River near Elliston offers camping on the Helena National Forest and excellent fishing along the river.
- 12** Rimini, an old mining town, offers snowmobile trails in winter, and camping and picnicking at Moose Creek Campground and Tenmile Picnic Area.
- 13** Park Lake, 15 miles southwest of Helena, is popular for fishing and camping during the summer months.
- 14** Great Divide Ski Area offers down-hill skiing above the historic gold mining town of Marysville.
- 15** Stemple Pass, 30 miles northwest of Helena, has the finest cross-country and telemark skiing in the Helena area.
- 16** The Smith River is popular for its fine trout fishing and is 60 mile, three-to-four-day flat trips. Permit required.
- 17** Lincoln and the Blackfoot River valley are a popular gateway to the vast Bob Marshall-Scapegoat Wilderness complex. The area is renowned for its snowmobile and hiking trails.
- 18** Tizer Botanic Gardens and Arboretum includes thousands of plants and several theme gardens. Located 18 miles south of Helena on exit 176 on 1-15.

HELENA POLICE DEPARTMENT

Mission Statement: *We are dedicated to providing our community with professional law enforcement services through equitable enforcement of the law, continued professional development, and respect for the needs of our citizens. We remain committed to the protection of human rights and focused upon making Helena a safe place to live and work.*

The Helena Police Department strives to maintain an open and positive relationship with the public, and understands this relationship must be based upon mutual confidence and trust. We aim to provide professional, timely and efficient law enforcement services to the citizens of Helena and the surrounding areas. If any of our personnel act in a way to discredit our agency or the City of Helena, we want to know about it.

Police Officers assigned to the Patrol Division are responsible for responding to calls for service within the city limits, providing preventative patrols, enforcing state laws and city ordinances, performing traffic enforcement duties, conducting preliminary investigations, preparing documentation for trial, and testifying in court.

The Helena Police Department is administered by the government of city of Helena in Montana. The department is responsible for providing crime prevention and investigation services. It operates administration and support service divisions. The Helena Police Department, through its patrol division, organizes several fitness and incentive programs for members. The department features various locker rooms, in-house fitness and shower facilities. It has undertaken projects for Helena Middle School, Capital High School and Helena High School. The Helena Police Department offers information on problems related to missing animals. The department's Drug Abuse Resistance Education program is a joint venture between Lewis and Clark County Sheriff's Office.

CITY OF EAST HELENA POLICE DEPARTMENT

HELENA

Mission Statement: *The members of the Helena Fire Department proudly continue the tradition as Guardians of the Gulch, by professionally providing a quality, effective, skillful, safe and caring service to protect our community whenever and wherever needed.*

The Helena Fire Department is a proud member of the Lewis and Clark Rural Fire Council and the Tri-County Fire Safe Working Group.

The history of the Helena Fire Department was born simply of necessity and the matter was taken in hand as shown in the aforementioned newspaper articles.

The constant threat of complete destruction by fire of this newly born city made Helena very cognizant of the danger that ultimately did leave it "a heap of ashes." These conflagrations lead to the eventual formation of a part paid, mostly volunteer fire department on December 29, 1872. From its beginnings, the department operated from several stations generally in the area of what is today South Last Chance Gulch. Several years after Helena's incorporation as a city in 1881, the Helena Fire Department moved into the station at the newly built City Hall at Main and State Streets. From that location they protected Helena until that station was destroyed by the 1935 earthquake.

At that time, the Helena Fire Department relocated alongside the Helena Police Department in the A-A Garage at the end of South Main. These buildings formerly housed the trolleys that operated in the area and were also known as the "car barns."

On March 10, 1939, the Helena Fire Department was moved to its current location on the east side of the Civic Center on Neill Avenue. This station has been in continuous operation since that time. This main station was remodeled in 1977, expanding its living quarters and providing more office space. With the addition of a second station on the east side of Helena in 1978, the Helena

Fire Department continued to provide the citizens of Helena with protection from fire, but also added response to many other types of emergencies that arise in our community.

EAST HELENA

The East Helena Volunteer Fire Department is the primary fire response agency for the City of East Helena. Consisting of 16 volunteers, they are prepared to respond to both the fire and medical needs of city residents, they are an all volunteer fire department that provides fire suppression, Emergency medical services and many other services to the community and surrounding area.

MONTANA CITY

Montana City Volunteer Fire Department is an all-volunteer fire department dedicated to the protection of life and property in our community and surrounding areas. Located in northern Jefferson and Lewis and Clark Counties in Montana, we serve a population of just over 3,000 in an area of 35 sq. miles. We respond to wide variety of incidents including structure fires, wildland fires, vehicle accidents/extrication/fires, medical emergencies, rope rescue, and hazardous materials. We operate out of two stations with an Engine, Tender, and Wildland/Medical Truck in each station. Our firefighters strive to bring the community we serve the finest protection possible.

Fire protection and rescue services in Jefferson County are provided by your local volunteer fire departments. Those fire departments are staffed by your friends and neighbors. If you've been looking for a way get involved and give back to our communities then this is your opportunity.

Municipal Parks



Helena's city parks offer a number of different options for resting and recreating. The parks feature facilities ranging from simple picnic tables and shelters to playing fields, playground equipment, and hiking trails. For information about parks, call 406-447-8462 or visit helenamt.gov/Departments/Parks-Recreation-and-Open-Lands.

- **Helena Skate Park:** For avid skateboarders looking for a place to catch some air and practice your carving, kickflips and grinding, check out the Helena Skate Park. This 17,000-square-foot park has proven to be an increasingly popular social and recreational destination for Helena's youth. It features quarter pipe corners with flat bank hips, two different gaps with ledges, a pyramid with a square tube rail and five benches. One of the benches has a curved edge, one is sloping, another has a step at the top and yet another has a rail that is two feet high. Located at 1200 North Last Chance Gulch, the park is free to everyone and welcomes boarders and inline skaters. Scooters and BMX bikes are prohibited.

- **Barney Park:** Cleveland and Hudson streets. Features barbecue pits, basketball hoops, a ball field, a picnic shelter, playground equipment and tennis courts.

- **Batch Fields:** Benton and Cole Avenues. Includes a picnic shelter, covered playground equipment and four softball fields.

- **Beattie Park:** Helena Avenue and Roberts Street. Includes historic sites and picnic shelters.

- **Centennial/Bausch Park:** Across the street from Memorial Park at 1200 N. Last Chance Gulch. Facilities include the Helena Skate Park for skateboarding, soccer fields, softball fields, dog park, bike track, horseshoe pits, and trailhead for Rails to Trails walking trail. The skate park provides dawn to dusk exercise for skateboarders and in-line skaters. Bikes, scooters and motorized vehicles are prohibited. Spectators and food and beverages should stay out of the immediate skate park area.

- **Cherry Hill Park:** Columbia Street and Cherry Avenue. Picnic facilities, playground equipment, shelter and basketball court.

- **Clinton Park:** State and Beattie streets. Features basketball hoops, a picnic area and playground equipment.

- **Constitution Park:** Sixth Avenue and Last Chance Gulch. Features historical information and monuments.

- **Cunningham Park:** Flowerree Street and Cleveland Court. Features basketball hoop, picnic area and a playground.

- **Fire Tower Park:** Surrounds Helena's Guardian of the Gulch, a wooden fire tower perched over downtown. The tower was built in 1874 to house men watching for fires in the valley. The tower is fenced in and not available to the public, but you can still get a similar view from the park area. To reach the park, walk up the winding path near Lewis and Clark Library at the end of Last Chance Gulch.

- **Heritage/ Pioneer Park:** East of the Lewis and Clark Library at 120 S. Last Chance Gulch. It includes historic monuments and playground equipment.

- **Hill and Women's Parks:** Two parks on opposite sides of Fuller Avenue. Hill is on the corner of Neill and Park Avenues; Women's is on Fuller and Neill Avenues. Features include historic monuments and picnic facilities.

- **Jaycee Park:** Approximately 1.7 acres and located at the intersection of Benton Avenue and Barney Street.

- **Kay McKenna Park:** Neill and Benton Avenues. This park adjoins the city's Civic Center entertainment facility. It includes historic sites, play equipment, tennis courts and picnic facilities.

- **Kessler Park:** Davis and Beattie Streets. Features a picnic area.

- **Lockey Park:** Lamborn Street and Broadway. Includes basketball, football, tennis, baseball and softball facilities as well as barbecues, shelter and playground equipment.

- **Memorial Park:** 1200 N. Last Chance Gulch, the site of an elaborate playground called Frontier Funtown. The playground, with features for park-going kids of all ages, was built by community volunteers. The park also features an outdoor public waterpark, barbecue pits and picnic

shelters. During the summer, it is the center for band concerts every Thursday night and adjoins Kindrick Legion Baseball Field.

- **Mount Helena Park:** A more than 1,000-acre natural city park featuring Douglas fir forests and expansive grassland areas. Two trails leave the parking area and circle the mountain. The park adjoins National Forest land and is a good spot for observing a variety of wildlife, including prairie falcons, meadowlarks and deer.

- **Mountain View Park:** Located on South Alice St. in the Mountain View Meadows subdivision. Features basketball, tennis, pickleball, and horseshoe courts; a log pavilion with picnic tables, a dog park, grassy area for sports, and space to practice disc golf.

- **Nature Park:** Cole and McHugh. A natural area with wildlife and a paved, accessible trail.

- **Northwest Park:** 101 Valley Drive. Features softball, soccer fields and walking trail.

- **Pioneer Village Park:** Approximately 0.5 acres and located on Colter Loop.

- **Pocha Park:** Ewing and Miller streets. Features a picnic area and playground equipment.

- **Ramey Park:** Corner of Missoula and Roberts. Offers soccer field, playground equipment, basketball court, and two softball fields.

- **Reber Park:** approximately 1.4 acres and located at the intersection of University Street and Flowerree Street in the City of Helena.

- **Robinson Park:** Livingston and Townsend Avenues. Features a football field, soccer field and picnic shelter.

- **Sixth Ward Park:** Montana Avenue and Bozeman Street. Picnic area and playground.

- **Skelton Park:** Located along Road Runner St. across from St. Peter's Health Northside Clinic. Picnic area and playground.

- **Waukesha Park:** Waukesha Avenue and Garrison Street. Football/soccer field, community garden plots and playground equipment.

- **Wesleyan Park:** Helena Avenue and 4th Street. Features a picnic area and playground equipment.

Winter Activities

Feel the cold on your cheeks and anticipate the hissing of freshly groomed ski trails. Pack your gear and round up family and friends for a day on the slopes at Great Divide Ski Area. This historic ski area is a family-owned and operated facility with over 1,500 skiable acres.

Looking for a more mellow day in the mountains? Grab snowshoes or a fat bike and explore some of our 80 miles of trails starting from the heart of Helena's downtown. Want a little more solitude, drive 12 minutes to the top of the Continental Divide for groomed cross-country trails!



Scenic Routes

Augusta Route Tour is about three hour's drive time away from Helena. Begin this 131-mile tour by driving north on Montana Avenue to Lincoln Road, then take Highway 279. When you get to the sign for Marysville, turn left for a seven-mile side trip to the site of the Drumlummon Mine and surrounding ghost town. Head back down to Highway 279 and proceed northwest to Canyon Creek. Eight miles farther north is Highway 200. Continue on the Augusta Route by turning right on Highway 200. Along the way you will find Flesher and Stemple passes. These passes offer scenery perfect for hikers, photographers and wildflower seekers and provide great opportunities for biking and hiking on side trails. To get to either pass, travel west through Canyon Creek and watch for the Stemple Pass turn off to the left. Stay on the Lincoln Road to the top of the divide to find Flesher Pass.

The Continental Divide offers breathtaking scenery just half an hour away from Helena. These passes offer camping, biking and hiking opportunities. You will cross the Continental Divide again at Rogers Pass soon after the turn from 279. Gravel roads north of Augusta take you to Willow Creek Reservoir, Nilan Reservoir or to Gibson Dam on the Sun River. When you turn back from Augusta, follow Highway 287 all the way to I-15 and head to Wolf Creek. You can exit the Interstate to take a look at Holter Lake and the Missouri River. I-15 takes you up the canyon and all the way back to Helena.

Lincoln Route Tour (130 Miles) To make your loop tour in another direction, begin on 279, as noted on the Augusta route above, but turn left of 279 when you reach Highway 200 from Flesher Pass. As you head toward Lincoln, you'll begin to see the Blackfoot River

as it winds its way through this valley. This area is great for snowmobiling, fishing, camping and hiking. Lincoln is a great place to stop for refreshments before continuing on your tour westward on 200. Browns Lake, a designated wildlife viewing area, is further ahead. You can continue on to the small town of Ovando, enjoying your view of the Scapegoat Wilderness to the north. Then backtrack on Highway 200 to the junction with Highway 141 and turn south. This road will take you to the ranching community of Helmville at the foot of the Garnet Range. From Helmville, get back on 141 and make your way through this agricultural valley to the town of Avon on the Little Blackfoot River. You may see beaver slide hay stackers in the fields, unique to this part of the country. Turn left on Highway 12. Stop at the viewpoint at the top of MacDonald Pass for a glorious view of Helena and the surrounding mountains. From the top of the pass, you'll descend swiftly back into Helena.

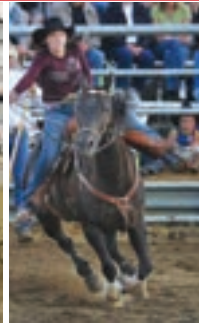
East Helena 4th of July Celebration

Helena has many opportunities to explore the past all while enjoying the new developments of the future. Whether you are interested in a tour, performing arts or getting out for some fun in the sun there is something for everyone.

STATE CAPITOL ROTUNDA

1301 E. 6th Avenue

No trip to Helena is complete without visiting the Montana State Capitol. Situated on 10 acres of spacious lawns, Montan's Capitol looks north over the Prickly Pear valley. Step inside to discover its history and classical architecture



and view the paintings and murals of renowned western artists. Around the stunning rotunda are four round paintings showing four important kinds of people in Montana's early history: the Native American, the explorer, the gold miner and the cowboy. Explore the Capitol on your own with the aid of self-guiding tour booklets and a scavenger hunt for kids. These are available at the information desk on the first floor of the Capitol. The building is open Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Self-guided tour brochures are available on site or at the Montana Historical Society.

CATHEDRAL OF ST. HELENA

The Cathedral of St. Helena began as a vision founded in faith by Bishop John Carroll and wealthy miner turned banker, Thomas Cruse.

According to Louie Gloege, parish business manager for the Cathedral, Bishop Carroll selected the site for the building after scaling Mt. Helena and surveying the area. He wanted the mother church

for the Diocese of Helena to be visible from anywhere in town. The land was purchased in 1905 through a generous contribution by Thomas Cruse. Construction on the cathedral began in 1908. The church wasn't fully completed until June of 1924.

The external building is built with limestone from Bedford, Indiana, considered to be sturdier than Montana sandstone. White marble altars, statues carved in Carrara marble, and genuine gold leaf gilding decorate the sanctuary space. The Cathedral's windows depict intricate scenes of events from the Bible and church history.

LAST CHANCE TOUR TRAIN

HISTORIC REEDER'S ALLEY

Situated in the southwest corner of downtown Helena, Reeder's Alley is the oldest intact piece of early Helena. The year 1864 marked the beginning of a tiny settlement and Helena's transition to a mining boomtown. Four prospectors found gold in a small stream they dubbed "Last Chance." The Pioneer Cabin, just north of the entrance to Reeder's Alley, is the oldest documented dwelling in Helena.



GATES OF THE MOUNTAINS BOAT TOUR

On July 19, 1805, Meriwether Lewis stopped to pen his observations of the Helena area's most awe-inspiring natural attraction—the Gates of the Mountains on the Missouri River just north of Helena. Suddenly, there loomed before them towering rock formations unlike anything they had ever seen. From



both sides of the river, limestone cliffs rose to a spectacular height of 1,200 feet. Visitors to the Gates of the Mountains can experience the rising cliffs and mighty river in nearly the same way Lewis and Clark did on their passage through the Missouri River corridor. Two passenger boats embark on guided scenic tours of the area every day beginning May 27.

GUARDIAN OF THE GULCH FIRE TOWER

The Old Fire Tower, called Guardian of the Gulch, is an official



Helena landmark. This 25-foot fire tower was originally built in 1876 after a huge fire destroyed the downtown area. The Guardian of the Gulch was manned around the clock to keep watch over the city. The Guardian is the last remaining tower of the many that once existed in Helena.

The Mount Helena Trailhead features several trails but is highlighted by the popular 1906 trail. This is a moderately difficult trail that will take you to the summit of Mount Helena, a hike that can be expected to take approximately 2 hours to complete.



LAST CHANCE GULCH

Discovered in 1864, the thoroughfare which was built down the Gulch was originally named Main Street. It remained that way for some 85 years, until July 20 1953, when acting Helena Mayor Dr. Amos R. Little, Jr. signed an ordinance officially changing the name of Main Street to Last Chance Gulch. Last Chance Gulch meanders as it does because it was originally routed between mining claims.

Disc Golf

If you're looking for a new summer sport, try your hand at Folf, or Frisbee golf. Helena is the birthplace of disc golf in Montana and has more folf courses than any other town in the state. If you're visiting Helena post to the Sleeping Giant Disc Golf Alliance Facebook page and one of the members may be able to join you or at the very least, give you some tips for the course. Or you can email them at thesgdga@gmail.com.

Blue Cloud, 18 holes. Go west out of Helenax, turn right at the Baxendale Fire Department. Take first right and follow road, at the next "Y" intersection, go left. At the next gate, go through and turn to your right. Follow down through the meadow and into the trees. At the "Y" intersection go right and you are at the parking area.

Huckleberry Hollow, 18 holes. There is a temporary course at the top of Priest Pass on National Forest Land called Huckleberry Hollow. Features 18 holes with objects and multiple dirt tee pads. This course is long and very prone to fast weather changes and high wind, so dress accordingly and be prepared for inclement weather. Also, pack sufficient water. Camp anywhere around hole one. Go west out of town toward Missoula. Before MacDonald Pass at the bottom, take a right just after Priest Pass Road sign. Follow Priest Pass Road to the top of the pass. Turn right at the elevation sign that reads 5,994 feet and park in the field. The first hole is the logging road to the right.

Hyzer Hills - Disc Golf Course, 18 holes. Take the South Hills exit off of I-15. Turn right onto Saddle Drive at the round-about. The course is on the south side of Saddle Drive. True folf course with rubber tee pads and basket targets.

Scratch Gravel Hills, 18 holes. From Green Meadow Drive go north to Franklin Mine Road and turn left, go west to Tumbleweed Drive and take a right. The road ends at the course parking lot.

Shady Scratch, 18 holes. Hilly area west of Green Meadow Drive. Go past the turn to Regular Scratch Gravel and proceed north on Green Meadow Drive past the blinking light. Turn left onto Norris Road and follow to turn around in the parking area. Go through wooden gate and veer to the left, follow the trail to hole number I.

Sheep Mountain, 18 holes. This is a good course for technical players who like shorter holes. Take I-15 south to Clancy. Exit there and take a right. The road splits off to the left, stay on the right and turn right. Follow road up to Sheep Mountain Road. Turn right and go a mile or two and you will see the course as you drive through it.

South Hills, has a good mix of right, left, trees, open, lanes, moderate elevation changes and distances. From I-15: take exit I90 (S. Helena). Turn west and go straight through the roundabout. Halfway up the hill on your left is the course.
